FOIA Overview



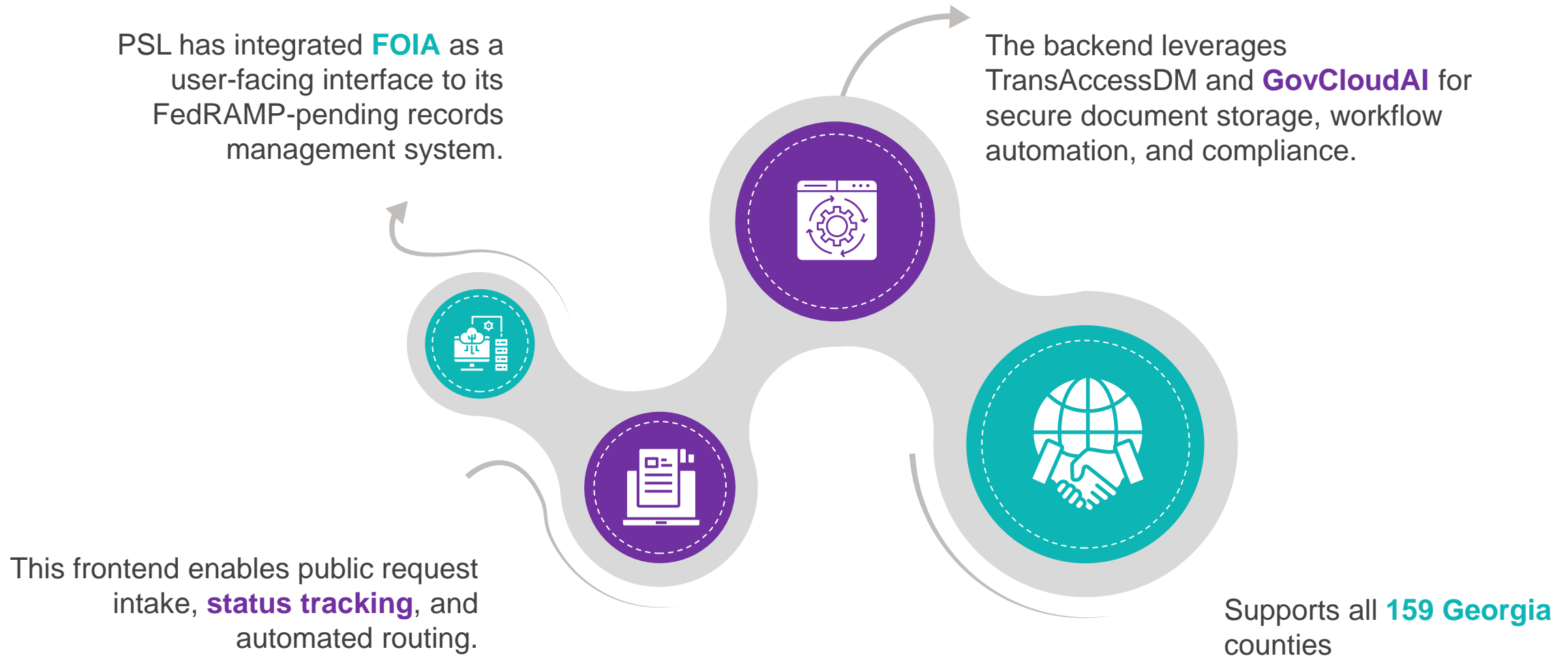
The Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) ensures public access to government records.

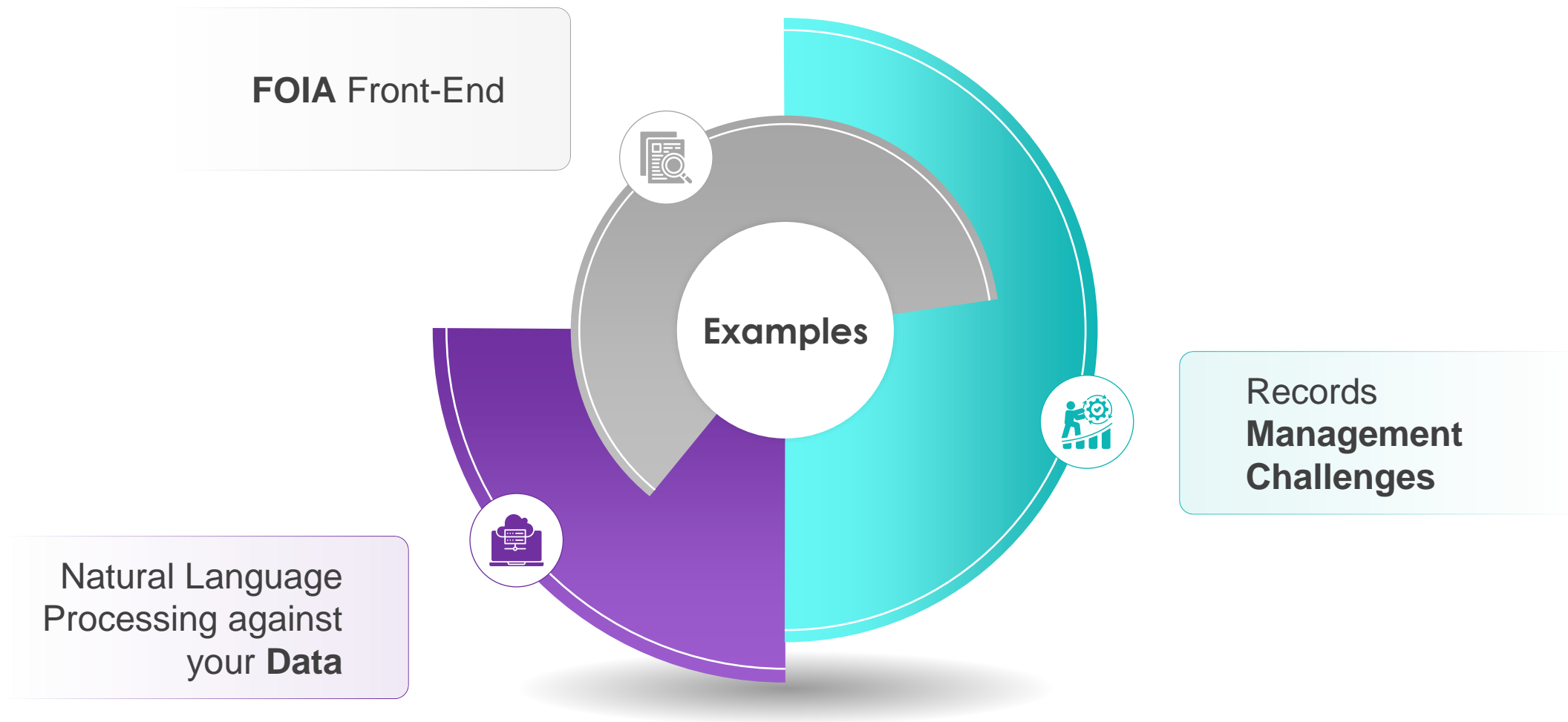

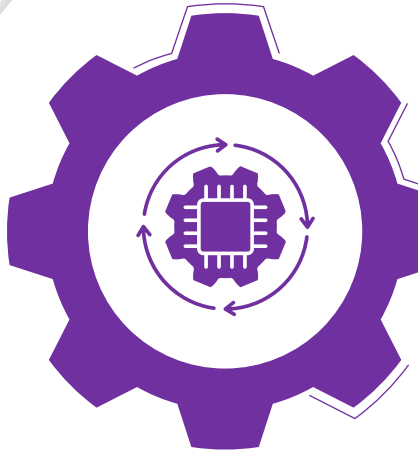

Embedding models and vector databases enable semantic search across **12TB+** of records.



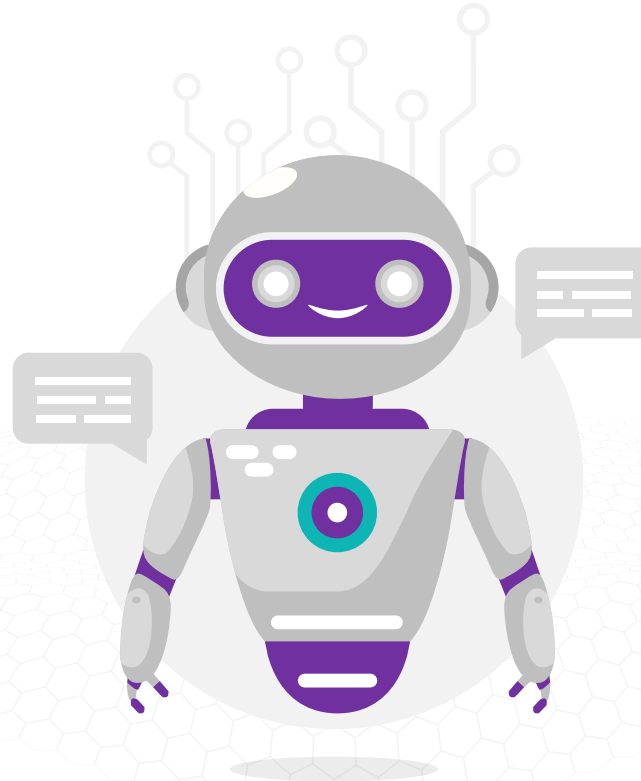

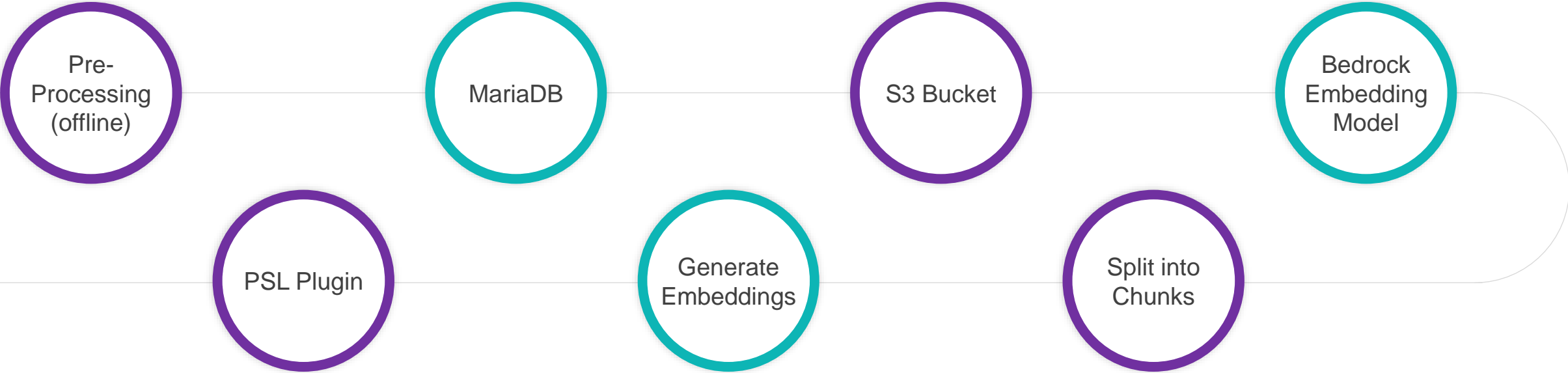
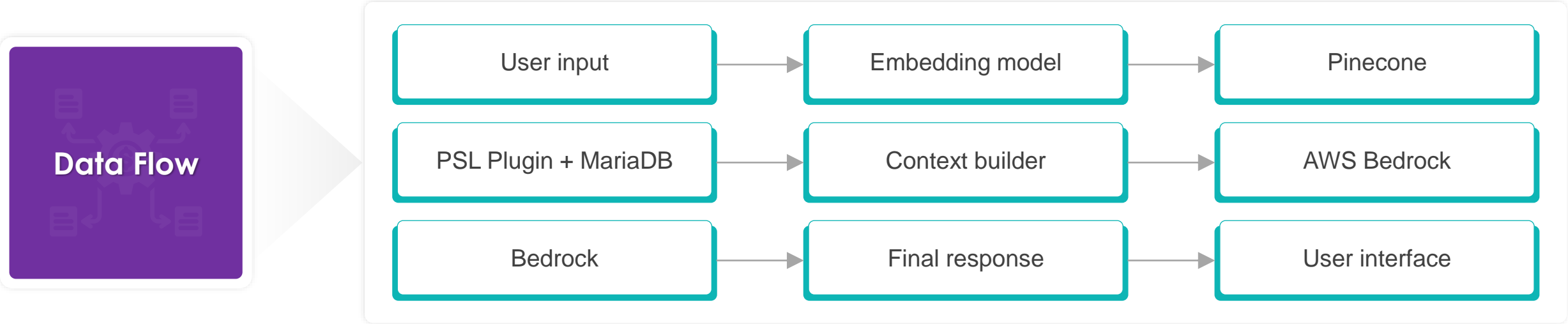
PSL uses **Amazon Bedrock** for Retrieval-Augmented Generation (RAG) to enhance document discovery and summarization.
